ELIZA ANN BARGER

Eliza Ann Barger, for fifty-two years a resident of this village and vicinity, died last Monday, of cancer, aged sixty-five years. Miss Barger was a sister of John and Guy Barger and Mrs. Brown, of this village and was born at Staten Island, NY in 1821. During the year 1834 she came to Michigan and settled in Rochester, where she has resided as above intimated, nearly ever since. She was formerly a member of the Christian Church but severed her connections with it some years ago, since which time she has been an attendant at the M. E. Church. For a long time she had been a victim to cancer in its worst form. Just one week before the day of her death, she fell and broke her leg which aggravated her condition and hastened her end. The funeral was held at the house Tuesday afternoon, Rev. W. H. Mills conducting the services.
