FIDELIA W. WARDEN DEWEY

Fidelia Warden was born Jan. 25, 1833, in Warren County, NJ. Came to Michigan with her parents when two years old. Was married when quite young and by this former husband had a daughter, who died in Pontiac at the age of 16 years. She was married to E. H. Dewey October 26, 1856; died at Rochester, October 27, 1904, aged 71 years, 9 months and 2 days. For 48 years and one day they lived together, save 18 months, during which time Mr. Dewey was engaged in the civil war.

In the year 1870 they came to Rochester and settled one mile east of the present home, living there two years. For the past 32 years they enjoyed life together at the late home.

Her husband, one brother and several nephews and nieces are left to mourn her departure. Interment took place Sunday afternoon, Oct. 30, the funeral being held at the M. E. Church, of which Mrs. Dewey had been a loyal and devoted member for thirty years. Many beautiful flowers were sent. The I.O.O.F., W.R.C. and O.E.S. were in attendance, the later society having charge of the exercises at the grave. The entire community sympathizes with Mr. Dewey in his great loss.
