

GEORGE DUNLOP

Memorial services for Pvt. George Dunlop were held in solemn dignity and amid a group of his friends and friends of his family at 3pm last Sunday in St. Paul's Methodist Church, with Rev. A. P. Richard and rev. William H. Collycott in charge.

George was killed in action on January 15 in Belgium, one of the many thousands of American soldiers who fell while stopping the big offensive drive of Gen. Von Runstedt.

As the price for such victories becomes known, Rochester's list of those who are paying, and have paid the supreme sacrifice, continues to lengthen.

The deepest sympathy of the whole community goes out to the Dunlop family, and to the wife and little daughter of George. Everyone knows that this loyal son of Rochester did his duty like all the men of the U.S. Army are expected to do.
