

SAMUEL J. DUNLOP

Samuel J. Dunlop, well known figure in Rochester for the past 36 years, died in the Mt. Clemens General Hospital on Tuesday evening following an operation Monday.

Mr. Dunlop was a native of Harbor Beach and he was born on March 15, 1860. He was associated with the D.M. Ferry Company for several years prior to his retirement.

He is survived by five children: Homer J. of Ferndale; Mrs. Earl Blair, of Petoskey; Mrs. Irl Palmer, of Rochester; Clyde of Rochester, and Mrs. LeRoy Barnes, of Lake Orion. There are 13 grandchildren surviving and 11 great grandchildren. Two sisters, Mrs. Catherine McNeely of Rochester and Mrs. Anna Goodrich of Ferndale, also survive.

Funeral services will be held on Saturday from the A.C. Hobart Funeral Home, at 2:30 in the afternoon. The Rev. William Hill Collycott, long time friend of Mr. Dunlop will officiate at the service. Burial will be in Mt. Avon Cemetery.
