Jacob B. Fox, aged 64 years, died very suddenly at Chico, California, April 22nd, and was buried under the auspices of Halleck Post G.A.R. Thirty-five years ago Mr. Fox came to Avon, and when the war broke out he joined the 22d Michigan Infantry, and served during the Rebellion. At the close of the war he returned to Avon and lived here until 1869 when he removed to California where he died as above stated. Mr. Fox will be remembered by many residents of Rochester as a wholesouled, honest man. He was a brother to Peter Fox of Avon, and Mrs. Chatfield, of this village.
