

## BENJAMIN GRAHAM

Benjamin Graham was born in the township of Avon, Oakland Co., Mich. October 9, 1834; died at the home of his sister, Mrs. V. Brown, in Orion, July 23, 1902, at the age of 67 years, 8 mo. 14 days.

His father and grandfather settled in the township of Avon in Feb, 1817, they being among the first settlers in Oakland County. In 1839 they sold this farm in Avon, and in 1840 he removed with his parents to the farm known as the Graham farm in Oakland township. Benjamin Graham was never married and leaves surviving him three sisters, Mesdames Lucinda VanWagoner, Vincent Brown and Robert Sims. He was an industrious man, a good citizen, a kind neighbor and leaves a host of friends to mourn his loss.
