

## P. N. HAGLE

Prof. P. N. Hagle, who was principal in our public schools here a few years since, died at his late home in New Haven, Macomb Co., last Monday, of consumption, aged 47 years. He had accepted a call to teach the Oxford school the coming year, but was obliged to resign on account of failing health. Mr. Hagle was a man of great strength of purpose, upright and honest to a fault, and possessing as he did, a kind and genial nature, he had endeared himself to a host of friends throughout the state, who will deeply deplore his taking off in the prime not only of life but in the midst of a useful and honored career. He leaves a wife and two children – the wife being a sister to Mr. W. S. Starring, of this village. Mr. S. left Tuesday last to attend the funeral of deceased. Mr. Hagle died as dies the Christian – his end was peace and full of a blessed hope beyond.
