

FANNIE LOUISA HARTWELL

Died, at Rochester, Mich., August 13, 1887, Mrs. Fannie Louisa, wife of John S. Hartwell. She was born in LeRoy, Genesee Co., NY, January 1, 1850. Was converted at the early age of eleven years, and baptized by Rev. E. F. Crane inside the fellowship of the Baptist Church at Clifton, NY. Removed with her parents to Michigan in 1863, and in the spring of 1867 moved to Rochester; soon after united with the Baptist Church of this village. Married to John S. Hartwell, July 2d, 1868, who, with three young daughters and an aged, invalid mother, survive to mourn her departure. Though somewhat hindered by feeble health, yet she was always ready to do all in her power in the work of the Master, leaving an example worthy of imitation.

Funeral services were attended from her late home Sunday, August 14th, at 3 o'clock pm. Sermon by her pastor, Rev. W. H. Mills, from I Thess., IV:18.
