

ALICE BECKWITH NEWBERRY HOWELL

Rochester, March 29, 1924 – Mrs. Alice Howell, 64 years old, practically all her life a resident of this place, died as a result of a paralytic stroke at the home of her daughter, Mrs. McCotter, of this place, early this morning.

Mrs. Howell was born about one mile southeast of Rochester in 1859. The illness which caused her death was of about one month's duration.

Surviving is the husband, William Howell, and six children, Arthur of Pontiac, John of Bad Axe, Mrs. Mabel Frank of Rochester, Mrs. Anna McCotter, Mrs. Leah Case and Milo Howell, all of this place. There are also three brothers, Arthur, Charles and Frank Newberry.

Funeral services will be held on Monday afternoon at 1:30 o'clock at the home of Howard McCotter, two miles south and one-half east of Rochester. Rev. L. L. Stedman of the Congregational Church will officiate. Burial will be in Rochester cemetery.
