Funeral services were held Tuesday afternoon (28 March 1935) at two o'clock from the A. C. Hobart Chapel for William B. Howell, 84 year old retired farmer of Avon Township. Rev. Clarence D. Oberlin, pastor of the First Congregational Church, officiated with burial in the Rochester cemetery.
