

ERNEST JONES

Ernest F. Jones, a former resident of Utica and late of Rochester, died at his home in this village, Dec. 4, 1903. Two weeks before his death he received a severe fall which terminated in typhoid fever. The funeral services were held at the Utica M. E. Church, Monday, Dec. 7, under the auspices of the I.O.F., with interment in Utica Cemetery.

Ernest F. Jones was born Jan. 18, 1857. He made his home at Utica with his grandfather, Hiram Squires, an old pioneer settler of Macomb County. In 1878 he went to Illinois where he met and married Mary Hill, at Plano, April 15, 1879. In 1881 he returned to Utica, and in 1900 he removed his family to Rochester where he resided up to the time of his death. He was engineer at the sugar mill when he was taken sick. He leaves a widow, two sons, Francis E. and Russell H., and a daughter, Maud L., to mourn the loss of a kind and loving husband and father.
