

JOHN V. LAMBERTSON

John V. Lambertson, a prominent shoe merchant of Caro and a former businessman of Rochester, father of R. J. Lambertson, died last Tuesday after a short illness of kidney disease, aged 69 years. In company with his brother Hiram, deceased, he built the old Lambertson House, now St. James, over forty years ago. He was at one time credit man for H. S. Robinson of Detroit and was years associated with his brother in the banking and mercantile business in this village and was then one of the most prominent men in Oakland County. He was a high Mason, and a member of Detroit Commandery, Knights Templar. Remains were brought to Rochester Cemetery for Interment.
