The burial of Mrs. Mary Morrison LeRoy, one of Oakland County's oldest settlers occurred in Rochester Tuesday afternoon. Mrs. LeRoy was born in Riga, NY 84 years ago and came to Oakland County in 1826, settling with her parents at Rochester. Later she was married to Daniel P. LeRoy who became one of the leading figures in Oakland County pioneer affairs and politics. It can be truly said of Mrs. LeRoy that she grew old gracefully. She resided in Rochester until 48 years ago, when she removed to Holly. For the past few years she has been living at the home of her son, L. P. LeRoy, at Barryton, Mecosta County. Mrs. LeRoy is survived by seven children: Mrs. L. Campbell of Ovid; Miss Edna LeRoy of Seattle, Wash.; L. P. LeRoy of Barryton, Mecosta Co.; Mrs. D'Ary of Wartburg, Tenn.; Miss Mina LeRoy of Greenville; and Orville M. LeRoy of Algonac County.
