

HOWARD K. MCCOTTER

Funeral services were held Sunday afternoon at three o'clock from the A. C. Hobert Chapel for Howard K. McCotter, 63, of 156 Albertson Street, Rev. Clarence D. Oberlin of the First Congregational Church officiated with interment in Rochester Cemetery. His six sons acted as pallbearers.

Mr. McCotter died last Friday (July 10, 1942) in Pontiac General Hospital after a long illness.

He was born June 2, 1879 in Vermontville, the son of James and Florence McCotter. He was a retired superintendent of the Ferry Morse Seed Farm, having been its head from 1914 to 1934. He succeeded his father who was the first superintendent of the Farm even before it was located south of town and was in Pontiac.

Mr. McCotter was a member of the Congregational Church.

He is survived by his wife, Anna, and the following children: Lee, Harold, James, Elbert and David, all of Detroit; Kenneth of Rochester; Mrs. Oliver Aldrich of Ann Arbor; and two sisters, Mrs. Harry S. Scudder of Cornwallis, Oregon and Mrs. Burton Snook of Phoenix, Arizona.
