

BURTON MORSE NEWBERRY

Burton Morse Newberry of 503 East University, Royal Oak, died February 16 (1945) in a Ferndale hospital following a brief illness.

Mr. Newberry was born in Rochester, April 21, 1883, the son of Milo T. and Eliza Baldwin Newberry. He graduated from the Rochester high School.

Mr. Newberry served as treasurer of Royal Oak Township in 1929 and 1930 and was a member of the North Woodward Real Estate Board and past president of the Hazel Park Exchange Club. He was an active broker in the State Land Sale.

Surviving is his widow, Orpha Patterson Newberry; four daughters, Mrs. Darrel B. Colley of Sacramento, California, Mrs. Russell E.
