

## GEORGE F. NEWBERRY

George F. Newberry, 71 years old, well known Lapeer man, died Thursday night of last week in Pontiac General Hospital as the result of a fractured skull suffered May 7 in an automobile accident near Pontiac.

Mr. Newberry was born July 10, 1867, in Romeo, and came with his parents to Lapeer when 7 years old, and spent his entire life in Lapeer County with the exception of several years in Pontiac. He married Sarah Louise Slater in 1886 and she survives him, together with the following children: Ms. Bert Witt of Pontiac; Mrs. Neal Frentheway of Lapeer; Mrs. Harold Stafford, of Detroit and Edgar Newberry of Dearborn; and one sister, Mrs. Clara Beardsley of Millington.

The body was at the Baird Funeral Home in Lapeer until Sunday at 11 am when it was taken to the First Baptist Church in Pontiac where funeral service was held at 1 pm, Rev. H. H. Savage officiating. Burial was made in the Rochester Cemetery, where a daughter is buried.
