

LYDIA B. SPRAGUE

Lydia B. Sprague, daughter of Joel and Anna Potter, was born in Homer Courtland Co., NY, September 28 1817. The family moved to Chili, NY in the spring of 1818, where they resided until June 1826. The family then moved to Michigan, settling in the township of Oakland, Oakland Co. At the age of 19 the daughter was married to Roger Sprague. They then settled on the farm two miles south of Rochester, where she spent the remainder of her life. Mr. Sprague dying nine years ago. After a long sickness, Mrs. Sprague died October 25, 1901. She was the mother of four children, of whom three survive, Rhoda W. dying at the age of 19. The surviving children are: E.N. Sprague of Wexford Co., Mrs. Thomas Dorman of Muskegon and Mrs. Peter Lehman. (Bottom half of this obit torn away)
