

RHODA TROWBRIDGE

Mrs. Rhoda Trowbridge, widow of the late Amariah C. Trowbridge, of Troy Township, died at her home in Troy, Friday, July 19, aged 73 years. Deceased was the daughter of Geo. W. Postle, and sister of the late George Postle; was born in Pittsford, NY, coming to Michigan and Avon in infancy with her parents. She was married to Mr. Trowbridge, April 1, 1836, E. W. Peek Esq., of Troy tp. issuing the marriage license. She lived on the farm located from the government; from the date of her marriage up to about 1880, when the farm was sold, and the family removed to Troy Corners. Mr. Trowbridge died about two years ago aged 82 years. Deceased leaves a family of four adult children; two are businessmen at Manistee; two daughters, the wives of J. C. Frank and Sam'l Butler of Troy tp. Both the husband and wife were among the early members of the Troy Presbyterian Church and held their membership during the existence of the local society. The golden wedding of the aged couple was celebrated a few months prior to his death, some two years ago. Their names are worthy of a record among the list of the early pioneers. (Bill Poster)
