

B. GRANT UNDERWOOD

Benjamin Grant Underwood died at his home in Underwood, Hall Co., Nebraska, June 20, 1899, aged 68 years, 7 months and 23 days. He was born near Rochester, Michigan, and was a brother to Miss. A. Underwood, the late Mrs. I. Barwise, Mrs. George Sipperley and Mrs. Burd of Rochester. He lived in the immediate vicinity of his birth place until April 1884, when he removed with his family to their present home in Nebraska. In 1857 he married Miss C. A. Lerich of Utica Plains, who with five sons and one daughter survive him, one son dying in 1893. He had been in failing health for about seven years. Eighteen months ago he was stricken with paralysis, which unbalanced his mind while another stroke, twelve weeks ago, left him helpless and speechless, continuing in that condition until death came.
