A.W. Webster of South Avon died on Monday last, in his 90<sup>th</sup> year. Mr. Webster was born Jan 10, 1811 and was one of the early pioneers of this part of the state. When he came to this part of Michigan the Indians were his neighbors and the white citizens were very few. The deceased had accumulated a competency and had been a man of vigorous life. Two daughters and a brother survive him. Funeral services were held from the late residence just south of the stone blacksmith-shop on Wednesday, 1:30 pm, Rev. O. J. Blackford officiating. Interment in Union Corners Cemetery.
